
# 1. For your safety

### 

Read this manual thoroughly before installation. Incorrect installation or usage may cause malfunction, or serious injury and death.


- 1) Turn off the power and disconnect electrical connection before installation, maintenance, and service.
- 2) Do not use the dishwasher if power cord is damaged.
- 3) Install the dishwasher at indoors with good ventiliation and without high humidity.
- 4) Do not unplug power cord with wet hand.
- 5) The dishwasher must be installed and serviced by a qualified technician.
- 6) Do not bend the power cord or put anything on it.
- 7) Keep the dishwasher away from children.
- 8) The dishwasher stops opertaion for safety if the door is opening during operation.
- 9) Do not open the door while the dishwaher is in operation.
- 10) Connect to the power supply with alternating 220V, 30 A or above only.
- 11) Call for a service immediately and disconnect power in case abnormal sound or smoke is coming from the dishwasher.



2. Connect drain hose into drain hole the kitchen.

# 5. Operation and Maintenance Guide

#### 1) Caution

- (1) Scrape off any large amounts of leftover food and soften remnants of burnt food in pans.
- (2) Soak utensils into the water before putting them into the machine if necessary.
- (3) Do not doulbe stack all utensils.
- (4) Do not open the door while the machine is in operation.
- (5) Use specialized detergent for dishwasher only.
- (6) Do not stack anything on the top.
- (7) Do not spray water over the dishwasher.

#### 2) For operation

- (1) Open water supply valve and turn on the circuit breaker.
- (2) Turn on the machine while door is closed.
- (3) Alarm will be ringing for three seconds once water supply cycle is done.
- (4) Open the door and put utensils into the machine for cleaning
- (5) Alarm will be ringing for five seconds once cleaning cycle is done.

#### 3) After using the machine

- (1) Turn off the machine and circuit breaker.
- (2) Close water supply valve.
- (3) Open the door and clean the machine after removing drain pipe.

#### 4) Cleaining

- Clean the dishwasher twice a day at least. More frequent cleaning might be required depending on installation condition.
  - (1) Turn off the machine and circuit braker.
  - (2) Remove leftover food on the filter.
  - (3) Rinse washing and rinsing tank with clean water.
  - (4) Swipe machine exterior with soft fabric.

## 6. Troubleshooting

#### 1) The dishwasher is not working at all

(1) Check if circuit breaker is on.

#### 2) Power keeps turing off

- (1) Press power button while the door is closed.
- (2) Check if the circuit breaker is in proper operation.

#### 3) Water is leaking

- (1) Clean water level sensor inside of washing tank.
- (2) Check if drain pipe is properly assembled.
- (3) Check if solenoid valve is in proper operation.

#### 4) Dishes are not completed dried

- (1) Check temperature by pressing 'stop' button and 'mode' button.
- (2) Check if rinse is properly supplied.

#### 5) Dishes are not completed washed

- (1) Check if water is propelry supplied.
- (2) Check if detergent and rinse are properly supplied.
- (3) Make sure dishes are not doulbe stacked.

#### 6) Too much bubbles are generated

- (1) Check temperature by pressing 'stop' button and 'mode' button.
- (2) Check if general dishwashing liquid is used during pre-washing procedure.
- (3) Remove all remaning water inside of washing tank and clean it.
